By signing below you acknowledge the following:

- You will wear a certified bicycle helmet.
- You will obey all traffic laws.
- No streets will be closed; normal vehicular traffic will be on the road through out the course.
- You will not race other riders, placing you or others in harms way on the city streets.
- Bicycle riding can be dangerous and even fatal.
- There is no supervision provided for bike rider on the city streets where you will be riding.

The Tour de Riverside is meant to be an enjoyable event for all, by signing below you will not hold Rotary International, its clubs, or their sponsors, members, and volunteers liable for any injuries/fatalities sustained by you in participating in the Tour de Riverside. By signing you also agree to release the City of Riverside, its employees, administrators, officers or elected officials from any liability for any claims made by you as a result of any injury or accident sustained in the Tour de Riverside.

By execution of this document, the party signing, for its heirs, assigns, executors, administrators, successors, representatives, employees, and agents, fully releases the sponsor of this event and assigns, executors, administrators, successors, representatives, employees, and agents, from all claims, demands, liens, interests, debts, actions and causes of action of any kind whatsoever, whether known or unknown, suspected or unsuspected.

It is understood and agreed by and between the undersigned that other damages not now known may develop or be discovered, or other consequences or other results may develop or be discovered, and this Agreement is specially intended to cover and include, and does cover and include, all such future damages or future consequences or results of known or unknown damages, including all rights of action therefore; that the provisions of section 1542 of the Civil Code of the State of California are expressly waived by all parties hereto, and all parties acknowledge that said section provides the following:
